SUPPLIES

- Assigned class textbook/scale book
- o Personal Planner to keep track of dates & assignments. Paper or technology
- o Correct sized-instrument
- Orchestra binder (purchase from boosters)
- *5 tabbed dividers, loose leaf paper (New Music, Notes, Assignments, Old Music, Handbook)
- *Shoulder rest, rock stop
- *Violin/viola Full set of extra strings (Dominant or D'Addario brand)
- o *Rosin, cleaning cloth, mute
- *Pencil in binder
- *Electronic Instrument tuner (label with name). Centerpitch PT10 (boosters have limited quantity for purchase)
- *Batteries for tuner
- School- assigned combination lock (violins & viola students)
- o Access to a computer and a printer, either at home or use Hebron library computers
- o Cellos and bass: cleaning rag, rosin in your school case and home case
- Cellos: strap-style rock stop labeled with your name

INSTRUMENT MAINTENANCE

Instruments must be maintained in good condition.

Purchase instruments from a reputable dealer who can do repairs onsite.

Upgrade your instrument once during middle school and at least once in high school.

Bows should be re-haired once per year.

Change strings as they go false or minimum every year.

CHANGE STRINGS ONE AT A TIME WITH AT LEAST 2 WEEKS IN BETWEEN FOR STRETCHING.

Rosin your bow EVERYDAY for best tone.

Wipe your instrument clean and loosen bow hair EVERYDAY.

Violins/Violas must keep instruments locked while at school.

Hebron how-to be in uniform

UNIFORM CHECKOUT

Each student will be issued a formal orchestra uniform and garment bag. The booster club will pay for one hem service and one dry cleaning. Turn in the uniform, garment bag (and book) at the end of year, or upon leaving orchestra. Uniforms are school property. Student records will be blocked in the school business office until everything is turned in. Students will be charged for loss or damage.

CARE OF UNIFORMS

- Uniforms are to be stored on a hanger in the garment bag at all times.
- o Dry clean only
- Iron on the lowest setting and only if absolutely necessary.
- o Do not cut the uniform or make any other alterations.
- Do not switch uniforms with another student. If you need a different size, you will need to check your uniform back in and check out a different one.

WEARING OF UNIFORMS

CASUAL UNIFORM: Visible orchestra shirt, jeans (no tears or holes), and sneakers. Students dress out in casual uniform at school on performance days for a daily grade.

CHAMBER ORCHESTRA MUSICAL/PIT UNIFORM: Nice black skirt/slacks, black blouse/shirt. Black closed toe shoes and black or flesh colored hosiery. No sneakers or jeans.

FORMAL GIRLS UNIFORM: Orchestra dress, black or flesh colored hosiery, and uniform shoes. Girls have a one-time purchase of uniform shoes. The only acceptable uniform shoe is the So Danca Character Shoe, black, with a 1½ inch heel. Please visit Spotlight Dancewear before uniform fitting.

FORMAL GUYS UNIFORM: Orchestra tuxedo, bow tie, cummerbund, LONG black dress socks (men's hosiery), black dress shoes. Guys must purchase a tux shirt, tie and cummerbund through the booster club. It is your responsibility to check the fit of your shirt each year and reorder if necessary.

ALL STUDENTS: Nails cut short, no nail polish while onstage. Stud earrings only. Remove watches, rings, necklaces and bracelets. Students will not be permitted to take the stage "out of uniform". You will be asked to sit in the audience during the performance and turn in a written concert evaluation the next day. Our uniform is a part of our visual presentation. We will look and sound professional at all of our events.
