Since instrument technique is a major factor in the audition any video without the left hand and right hand visible will receive zero points for this audition element. |
| All auditions are due by Sunday, April 30. Optional audition help sessions will be available after school at Hebron. Check www.hebronorchestra.org for dates and times. You may fill out and scan the Audition Questionnaire and Commitment Agreement or submit a paper copy. |
